If you sent in a volunteer-form we may already have signed you up. If you would rather work a different job/class, just remove your name from the slot and add it where you would rather help. We can't thank you enough for helping, but as a small token of our gratitude we will provide water, snacks and vouchers to use towards food at the snack-bar.

CHECK-IN and MEASURING

We will not be using Armband labels at these trials. We are scheduled to have a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) at our trial. All dogs needing to be measured must be measured PRIOR to running to be sure that you are in the correct jump height. Please remember that our VMO is a volunteer also entered in this trial. If our VMO is not available, you will need to be measured by the judge of record BEFORE your first run. Allow sufficient time before your dog's run to be measured. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be measured when needed. Measurements will take place before each class.

Additional SITE INFORMATION

- NO X-PENS in the Crating areas
- Crate in designated areas only – leave aisle ways and doors clear or we will have to move you.
- Please be considerate of others and conserve crating space. Stack crates whenever possible.
- Waterproof matting must be used under all crates to protect the floor
- No baby strollers in or around the rings.
- No smoking within 30’ of the building or near arena doors.
- Flexi-Leads MUST be kept at the 2’ LOCKED position when used IN and NEAR the building.
- ALL crates must be zipped when occupied by a dog.
- Scoop the Poop!!! Please!! We would like to return to this site and care of the facilities will help us do that.
- Please do NOT allow dogs to urinate on any plantings or fixtures around the edges of the buildings
- No outside food or drink is allowed in the field house. Water and dog treats allowed only. Food concessions are available for purchase on site each day.
- Hospitality and vouchers for food are provided to our wonderful volunteers!!
- We must vacate the building by 5 pm.

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. A green rosette will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

- Rosette for DoubleQ in Master classes.
- Special large rosette and MACH/PACH bar for any dog earning its’ first MACH/PACH title.
- Special Gray & Blue rosette for any dog completing a new title (including MACHs/PACHs beyond the 1st MACH/PACH).

MOVE-UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the April 23 trial no later than Monday, April 16th at 6pm.

..... Silver Platter

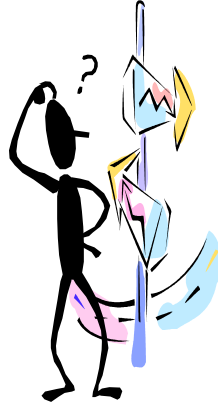
High Score in each of the classes is first determined by score and then the fastest yards per second in the Standard run. For the purpose of this award, the Novice A & B will be considered one class. Excellent Class only; Masters Class not included in this award. All runs must be qualifying runs.

From the Convention Center

Head East on 19th towards Parks Ave
Turn left on Parks Ave.
Turn left on I-264W towards Norfolk.
Take exit 19A for Lynnhaven Pkwy S.
Go 3 miles. Use the left two lanes to turn left on Holland Rd.
Turn right on Dam Neck Rd.
Turn left on Princess Anne Rd.
Turn right on Landstown Center Way.
The Field House will be the first building on your left.



From Lynnhaven Mall and points from the East

From 264 W, Take exit 19A Lynnhaven Pkwy. S and merge onto VA 414/ S. Lynnhaven Pkwy. Turn **left** onto Holland Rd. Turn **right** at Dam Neck Rd. Turn **left** onto Princess Anne Rd. Turn **right** at Landstown Centre Way. The Field House will be the first building on your left.

From Great Bridge and points from the South

Take S. Battlefield Blvd. towards Marion Dr.
Turn right onto Stadium Dr.
Take 2nd right onto Mt. Pleasant Rd.
Turn **left** at Centerville Turnpike S.
Turn **right** at Elbow Rd. Continue onto Dam Neck Rd.
Turn **right** at Landstown Rd. Take First **left** towards the Sportsplex, the Field House is on the left.

From the Downtown Tunnel and points from the West

Take 264 E towards Virginia Beach. Take exit 17A for Independence Blvd. S towards Princess Anne S.
Keep left at the fork to continue on S. Independence Blvd. and merge onto S. Independence Blvd. Take a slight **right** to stay on S Independence Blvd. Turn **left** at Princess Anne Rd. Turn **right** at Landstown Centre Way. The Field House will be the first building on your left.
