There is no crating allowed inside for exhibitors.
The parking lot will open at 7 am on Saturday & Sunday. Please respect our neighbors and do not arrive earlier.

WALKTHRUS

For EX/MAS STD and EX/MAS JWW

4" – 16"

Walk1- Walk 2 – Walk 3– Run All
No 5 minutes to 1st dog

- Groups will be marked clearly on Agility Gate.

20" – 24C"

Walk 1 – Walk 2 - Run All – No 5 min to 1st dog

- All other classes will have one walk.

No briefings for Ex/MAS classes. Judges briefings for Novice and Open classes only. Please wear your mask and social distance for the briefings.

CHECK-IN and MEASURING

Our Judge is a VMO. All dogs needing to be measured must be measured PRIOR to running by the VMO. Measurements will take place between classes. Please allow sufficient time before your dog's run to be measured. We will not be using Armband labels at these trials. However, you will need to know your Armband number in order to do an At Trial move-up. Please bring a printed or an electronic copy of your trial confirmation so you will have your armband number with you.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary in writing (E-mail preferred) prior to 6pm on Monday, May 10, 2021. Be sure that I have acknowledged receipt of your move-up. Please preface all correspondence with "BACV" in the Subject line. Make sure you know your armband number in order to do an At-Trial move-up. At-trial move-ups must be turned into the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the final class. The At-trial move-up binder will be by the whiteboard.

EMAILS ARE NOT ACCEPTED FOR AT-TRIAL MOVE-UPS.

You MUST fill out at a move-up at the trial to do an at-trial move-up – no exceptions.

SITE INFORMATION & RULES

- The show site is climate controlled indoors on turf flooring.
- There will be no spectators inside the building.
- There will be no worker hospitality or MACH/PACH cakes allowed.
- Do not park in front of any gate or doorway.
- All turf accidents must be reported immediately and \$5 clean up fee paid.
- Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring.
- A warm up area will be provided for all exhibitors outside the building.
- Respect the traffic cones when parking – they are marking the turning radius for truck traffic
- NO RV Parking Onsite – No Day OR Night Parking
- Do not potty your dogs on the neighboring tenants' lawns. They are graciously allowing us to park in their lots on the weekend. Please respect their property and do not let your dogs on their grass. **If you are caught, you will be asked to leave for the weekend and forfeit your runs.**

BACV Trial Updated COVID19 Procedures and Trial Info

You are required to sign the covid19 waiver to participate in the trial.

Please note that these rules have been updated to reflect the new COVID restrictions from the Governor's Executive Order Number 67 and Order of Public Health Emergency Seven.

- **Masks.** You must wear a mask at all times while on LUDS property. Mask MUST fully cover the nose and mouth, be snug to the sides of the face with no opening; i.e. no mesh, valves, etc. If you wear a face shield you must also wear a mask.
- **The updated mask policy means there is NO EATING OR DRINKING INSIDE LUDS.**
- **COVID Overseer.** A LUDS staffer will be in charge of COVID procedure inside and outside of the building. Anyone refusing to comply with current regulations will be asked to leave with no refund.
- **Social Distance.** Please maintain 6-10 feet of social distance at all times. We understand that people and dogs need to move around/stretch to get ready to compete – please be mindful and do not congregate on the grass, parking lot, while walking dogs, etc. If you are not getting ready to run or walking your dog, we ask that you stay in or near your car to help us keep everyone at safe distances around the property.
- **Crating.** Exhibitors must crate out of their vehicles. Please pack accordingly.
- **One way entry/exit** as follows: Enter the building on the parking lot side and exit on the other side where the street goes between the buildings.
- **Volunteers.** Worker sign-up link is posted on the GoneDoggin' Agility website. Bottled water will be available for volunteers.
- **Gate sheets** - check-in using the Agility Gate app. There will not be paper gatesheets.
- **Course maps** will be posted to the GoneDoggin' Website. www.GoneDogginAgility.com , no later than 9pm. They will also be uploaded to Agility Gate at the developer's convenience. The course maps will also be posted on the wall outside the ring, but please do not congregate around them. Use your phone camera to take pictures of the maps if you haven't downloaded the maps.
- **Briefings.** There will only be briefings for Novice & Open classes. No briefings for Ex/MAS - our judge will be available for questions if needed.
- A club member or gate steward will let each group into the building to walk, through the Entry door, once the previous group has completed their walkthrough and exited using the Exit door.
- Only the next 5 dogs in the ring will be allowed in the ring area. There will be room to stage five dog & handler teams while socially distanced inside the building.
- **Trial results** will sent out through the REMIND app. Previous day's results will be available for viewing on the table under the whiteboards near the entrance to the ring.
- **Ribbons** will be self-serve on a table for pick-up.
- As per AKC guidelines... "Exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, crossbody, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash the run will be scored as an "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog grabs the leash".

APPS to Help Keep Exhibitors Informed.

We will be using two apps to help manage the trial. Remind and Agility Gate. Please download Agility Gate and remind to your devices. **Please keep in mind that these apps are only an aid.** Exhibitors are still responsible for arriving on time for their walk-thrus and runs.

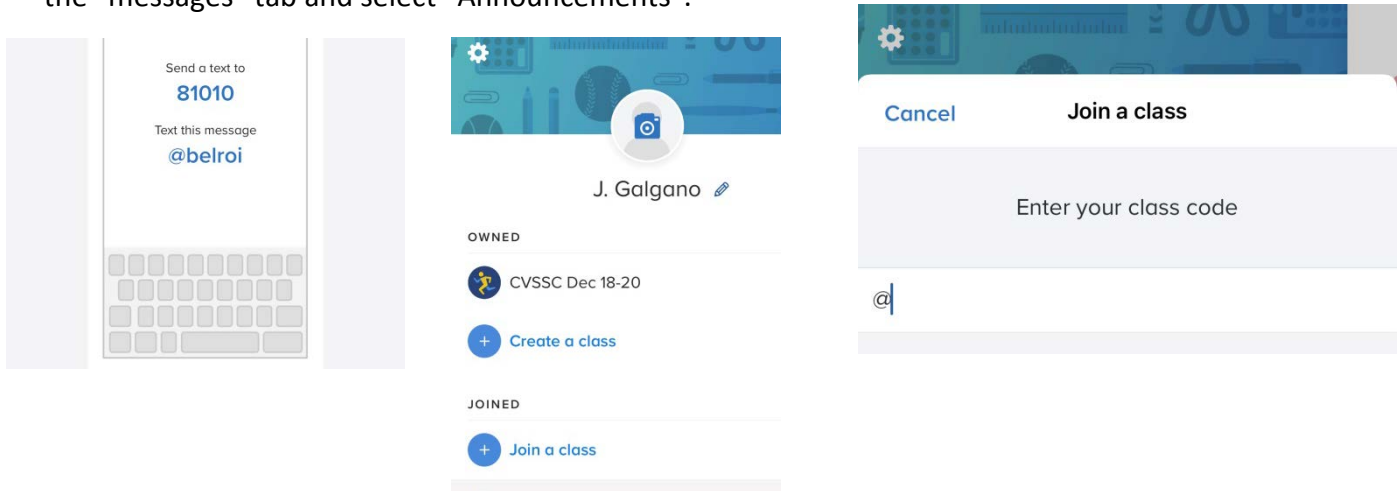
REMIND APP

We will be using the Remind app during the weekend to send announcements in order to keep exhibitors informed. Please use the following link to download the Remind app on your phone: [here](#)

Add the app to your phone and make an account (select parent as role). You can manually join the class by using the class name “belroi”.

You can also join by sending a text to 81010. Text this message: @belroi

Within settings (the gear icon), **you can change how you get notifications** – disable email and text messages if you don’t want your phone blowing up constantly. To check announcements, navigate to the “messages” tab and select “Announcements”.



AGILITY GATE APP

We will also be using the Agility Gate app. This allows exhibitors to check in for their runs through the app and to follow along by looking at the gate sheets as dogs are crossed off when they run. To use the Agility Gate app, please download it from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.

Using Agility Gate you can:

- Check in your dog / Mark your dog ABSENT / Mark a CONFLICT
- Follow in real time to see who is running in the ring using the running order. On the app you can see as the gate steward marks each dog on the line the same way you would see it on the paper gate sheets. You will be able to see the whole gate sheet to know how many dogs before your run or how many dogs are left in that class.
- Download the course maps *posting time is dependent on the schedule of the app developer*
- You cannot check-in until 6 am on the morning of each trial day. This is a precaution so people do not check in and then forget to mark themselves absent if they decide to not run.
- *The Agility Gate code will be emailed out closer to the trial*

**** Turn LEFT at the 1st light onto Richfood Rd. At mulch piles, turn LEFT onto Old Richfood Rd. Building will be on the RIGHT. Look for the Level Up Dog Sports sign.
