Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

Durham is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing on Apr. 3, 2012. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Sunday, Apr. 15, 2012 @ noon, will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sunday, Apr. 15, 2012 @ noon will receive a full refund.

I answer all correspondence and acknowledge receipt of all move-ups and corrections to entries. If you do not get a response within two days, please contact me.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Make checks payable to **Durham KC** and mail entries to Trial Secretary at the PO Box address ONLY.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, or fees, nor will telephone or FAX entries be accepted.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$30.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- Overnight service **MUST** be mailed through USPS, and you **MUST** check **AND** sign the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" waiver box as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.
- Limit 10 entries per envelope.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete
- Entries received with insufficient fees
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Durham Kennel Club and its agents, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The Durham Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Durham Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during walkthroughs.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

CLASSES OFFERED

EXC STD, EXC JWW, all levels of FAST and T2B will be offered on Friday.

All regular and preferred Standard, JWW & FAST will be offered on Saturday.

All regular and preferred Standard and JWW will be offered on Sunday. Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the April 20th trial no later than Monday, April 16th at 6pm. **Day to Day Move ups will be accepted for these trials but must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last run is judged for each class (STD, JWW and FAST).**

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. A dog toy valued at two-three dollars will be awarded to all dogs entered in the set of trials. A New Title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. DoubleQ ribbon will be awarded for those earning a DoubleQ in the EXC B classes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH Rosettes and a MACH/PACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH or PACH title at this trial.

All ribbons and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed.

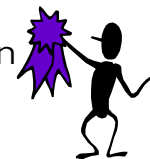


Durham Kennel Club is offering Team Competition at this trial. This is a non-AKC event designed just for the fun of it. Get together with your friends and make a team. The rules are as follows:

1. Each team consists of 4 dogs/handlers from the Excellent classes (A or B, regular or preferred). Any breed/height/handler combination is allowed.
2. Come up with a team name; be creative.
3. 1 point is given to a team for each speed (MACH/PACH) point its team members earn in the EXC B STD or EXC B JWW classes over the three day weekend. Speed (MACH/PACH) points earned by team members from EXC A STD or EXC A JWW will be worth 2 points each. Double Q's will add 10 points to the team score.
4. The winning team is the team with the most points at the end of the weekend. Prizes will be awarded for the top 4 teams at the completion of Sunday's Excellent level classes.
5. Entry fees are \$10 per team. Entries are to be made at the trial site on Friday, April 20th, prior to the start of judging. See Peggy Schmidt to enter.
6. At least one team member must be present to accept the prize.
7. In the case of tied scores, the team with the most double Q's will win.

3rd and 4th place teams

Each team member will receive a rosette & dog related item valued at \$5.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. *It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.*

Sunday HIGH to LOW (26, 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4)

EXC STD - EXC JWW – OPN STD - OPN JWW - NOV STD - NOV JWW

All A & B classes will be combined with B classes running first when possible.

Regular and Preferred classes will run concurrently.

OBSTACLES

REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

Injuries – Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund minus \$6 per run/per day. A written vet letter must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than the start time on the date of the trial.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- Food concessions will be available on the site.
- Overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. No electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). DIRECTIONS

From I-85 north or south, take US 501 north off I-85 (Exit 176, N. Duke St) go approximately 14.5 miles north to Rougemont (towards Roxboro). Turn left on Bill Poole Rd. (just before the traffic light in Rougemont). Travel 0.8 miles and turn left on road next to small white church. Durham Kennel Club property is at the end of the road.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
