CHECK-IN and MEASURING

We will not be using Armband labels at these trials. We are not scheduled to have a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) at our trial. All dogs needing to be measured must be measured by the judge of record PRIOR to running to be sure that you are in the correct jump height. Please allow sufficient time before your dog's run to be measured. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be measured when needed. Measurements will take place before each class.

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the April 26 trial no later than Monday, April 23rd at 6pm.

In 2.46 miles turn **RIGHT** onto Southgate Dr
In 0.50 miles enter the **ROUNDBOUT** and take the 3rd **RIGHT** to Duck Pond Drive
In 0.1 miles turn **LEFT** to 205 Duck Pond Drive

From the North

Take 81S toward Bristol
Take the US-11/US-460 exit, **EXIT 118C-B-A** toward Christiansburg/Blacksburg
In 0.06 miles to EXIT 118B (keep to the **LEFT** at the fork in the ramp)
In 0.80 miles to EXIT 118B (keep **RIGHT** at the fork in the ramp)
In 0.01 miles to EXIT 118B
(stay **STRAIGHT** to go onto US-460W toward Blacksburg Hospital)
In 5.5 miles take the US-460 BUS exit, EXIT 5BA toward Blacksburg
In 0.1 miles take EXIT 5A to the right onto

US-460E BUS/Blacksburg

In 0.3 miles turn **LEFT** onto Industrial Park Rd
In 0.1 miles turn **LEFT** onto S Main Street
In 0.4 miles turn **LEFT** onto Yellow Sulphur Rd
Make an immediate **LEFT** onto Holiday Lane.

In 42.4 miles take EXITS 118A-B-C to US-11/US-460
In 0.70 miles merge **LEFT** to EXIT 118B US-11/US-460
In 0.03 miles merge **RIGHT** to EXIT 118B US-11/US-460W
In 5.5 miles take the US-460 BUS exit, EXIT 5BA toward Blacksburg
In 0.1 miles take EXIT 5A to the **RIGHT** onto US-460E BUS/Blacksburg
In 0.3 miles turn **LEFT** onto Industrial Park Rd
In 0.1 miles turn **LEFT** onto S Main Street
In 0.4 miles turn **LEFT** onto Yellow Sulphur Rd
Make an immediate **LEFT** onto Holiday Lane.
