During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 83 runs online and 247 runs paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

The waitlist is not extended past closing for this trial.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Checks or money orders ONLY *NO CASH* payable to "GoneDoggin' Agility" and mail to Trial Secretary at the PO Box address ONLY.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will email, telephone or FAX entries be accepted. Overpayments of under \$10 will not be refunded.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid. ***PLEASE WRITE EMAIL ADDRESS LEGIBLY!!!
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$30.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- Overnight service MUST be mailed through USPS and you MUST check AND sign the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" waiver box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.
- Limit 10 entries per envelope.
- THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

We answer all correspondence and acknowledge receipt of all move-ups and corrections to entries. We usually respond within 2 days unless we are at a trial.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms OR on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current agreement and rule on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete or received with insufficient fees.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

CONFIRMATIONS

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.
- A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections.

- Final confirmations of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the e-mail address on the AKC form after the closing date.

REFUNDS

Bitches in season **will not be admitted to the trial**. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be on Veterinarian stationary and in the hands of the trial secretary 30 minutes before the start of the trial on October 23, 2017.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open only to Siberian Huskies only fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

CLASSES OFFERED

All levels of STD, JWW, and T2B (regular and preferred). Premier STD and JWW are not offered.

Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

RUNNING ORDER

HIGH to LOW (26, 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 4)

Classes will run in the following order:

T2B - EX/MAS JWW – EX/MAS STD – OPN JWW – OPN STD – NOV JWW – NOV STD

MOVE UPS

Move ups must be sent in writing (E-mail is acceptable and preferred) to the Trial Secretary for the October 23rd trial no later than Monday, October 16th at 6pm.

VETERINARIAN ON CALL

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

😊 **Simplified Jump Height Card Process** 😊

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

**It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.
Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

SHCA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. SHCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the SHCA or any official thereof.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season and Dogs under 4 months of age will not be admitted to the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

- **No Smoking on Trial Grounds**
All smoking must be done in individual cars or self-contained RVs. Please dispose of cigarette butts.

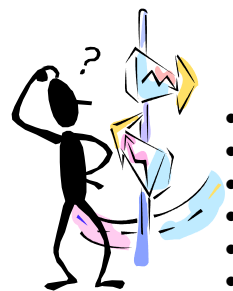


There will NOT be a Food Vendor on site.

From the South via Rt I-64 North

- I-64 West toward Richmond, Take Exit 231 A (Norge/Toano)
- At the end of the ramp, turn RIGHT on SR 607 (Croaker Rd).
- Go 1.5 miles to light. Turn RIGHT on Route 60 West (Richmond Rd)
- Go 1.8 miles. Turn LEFT on SR 610 (Forge Rd)
- Go 2.2 miles. Turn LEFT on Lakeview Dr
- Go ~ 1/8 mile to WHITE FENCING, gravel drive on LEFT

From the North via I-64 South (from the Northern VA and Richmond Areas)

- I-64 East to Williamsburg/Norfolk/Hampton to Exit 227 (Toano/Williamsburg)
- Turn RIGHT at the end of the ramp onto SR 30 Old Stage Highway

Agility High in Trial will be awarded from the STANDARD class, including Regular and Preferred to the Highest Scoring Siberian Husky. In case of a tie in score, then seconds under course time will be weighted as follows in determining HIT. Using the following calculation, High in Trial would go to the Siberian Husky with the highest number.

Novice Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 1

Open Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2

Excellent/Master Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3.

Novice: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2 with 5 points added

Open: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3 with 5 points added

Excellent/Master: Seconds under course time multiplied by 4 with 5 points added

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, agents, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
