ENTRY INFORMATION

- Checks or money orders ONLY *NO CASH* payable to "GoneDoggin' Agility" and mail to Trial Secretary at the PO Box address ONLY.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will email, telephone or FAX entries be accepted. Overpayments of under \$10 will not be refunded.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid. ***PLEASE WRITE EMAIL ADDRESS LEGIBLY!!!
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$30.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- Overnight service **MUST** be mailed through USPS and you **MUST** check **AND** sign the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" waiver box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.
- Limit 10 entries per envelope.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information
- Entries not on Official AKC forms OR on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current agreement and rules on the reverse side or attached to the entry form
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete or received with insufficient fees.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

CONFIRMATIONS

- Confirmations will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request.

REFUNDS

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season, on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time of the first trial on April 26, 2018.

INJURIES

Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a partial refund minus \$6.50 for the 1st run and \$6 for each additional run. A written vet certification, on veterinary letterhead, must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time of the first trial on April 21, 2018.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open only to Whippets fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

CLASSES OFFERED

Trial 1:

All levels of STD, JWW, and FAST (regular and preferred). Premier STD and JWW are not offered.

Trial 2:

All levels of STD, JWW, and T2B (regular and preferred). Premier STD and JWW are not offered.

Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

MOVE UPS

OBSTACLES

All obstacles and equipment used at this trial meet the requirements for agility trials.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

If your dog needs to be measured, check the box at the top of the entry form so that your dog is placed on the Measuring List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

AWC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. AWC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the AWC or any official thereof.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season and Dogs under 4 months of age will not be admitted to the trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Additional SITE INFORMATION

- High occupancy ex-pens (3 dogs or more) ONLY.
- Set-up will not be available on Friday night.
- The building will open at 7:30am on Saturday.
- **IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Crate aggressive dogs or dogs who create a disturbance must be covered and monitored by owners and may not be positioned in heavy traffic areas. The Event Committee may limit or move an exhibitor's crating area if it is in the best interests of the trial.
- **Crating space is limited.** Unentered dogs may be asked to leave.
- Be aware that Sprinturf requires specialized cleaning and a damage fee may be levied. Any accident on the Sprinturf will be fined \$5, payable at the score table.

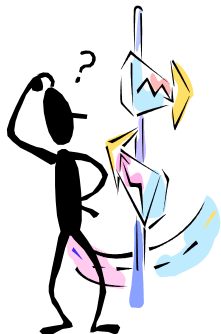

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Dogs must qualify to receive awards.

Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class. New Title rosettes will be awarded to all dogs earning a new title. A MACH/PACH/PAX bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH, PACH, or PAX title at these trials. If both a PAX and a PACH are earned, only one bar will be given. **Please indicate on the entry form if you and your dog may be earning a MACH, PACH or PAX title at our trial.**

Additional special prizes will be available and are described below. **Preferred and Regular classes will be evaluated together for the purpose of all the awards listed below.**

The following additional items will be awarded for Trial #1 (the official AWC National Specialty / Versatility trial):

- High in Event (a combined award, based on runs in both trials) - \$100 Clean Run gift certificate

Note: See following section for explanation on how High in Trial and High in Event will be calculated. All prizes must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

Worker Raffle and NQ Raffle will be offered.

A portion of the proceeds will go to the general agility ribbons fund. Direct shipping is available for those not attending the trial.

High in Trial and High in Event Calculation:

There will be one High in Trial (HIT) offered at the National Specialty Agility event for each of the 2 trials held on 4/21/2018.

Scores across all classes in the trial (FAST, STD and JWW for Trial #1, and T2B, STD and JWW for Trial #2) will be considered. In the event of a tie a runoff will be offered.

For each class level there are handicap points.

- Excellent level runs get 30 points
- Open level runs get 20 points
- Novice level runs get 10 points

This is to acknowledge the difference in skills difficulty required at the higher levels and to "level the playing field." *Since there is no level associated with T2B, this class will be assigned a score of 30 points, to allow credit for participation in that additional class.*

For each dog, a total score across all QUALIFYING runs is calculated. The difference between the standard course time (SCT) or maximum course time (MCT) and the dog's actual course time (rounded) is calculated across all qualifying runs and added to the total.

For example: If the standard course time is 63 seconds and the dog runs the course in 58.3 seconds, the difference is 4; if the standard course time is 55 seconds and the dog runs the course in 49.8 seconds, the difference for that course is 5.

The handicap for each class is added to the score plus difference in SCT/MCT and all dogs' totals are compared to determine the high scoring dog in each trial.

There will be one High in Event offered at the National Specialty Agility event. The high scoring dog in the event will be calculated by adding the total score for each dog for each trial to get a grand event total.

Example:

A dog runs and Qs in all 3 classes in trial #1. The total of the scores in all 3 classes for trial #1 is 285. Assuming the difference between SCT and run time across all 3 classes in trial #1 is 11, then that total is added to 285, for a new total of 296. If all 3 qualifying runs were from the Open class, 60 is added for the handicap, for a final trial #1 total of 356.

The same dog runs and Qs in 2 classes (STD and JWW) in trial #2. The total of the scores in both classes for trial #2 is 195. Assuming the difference between SCT and run time across both classes in trial #2 is 6, then that total is added to 195, for a new total of 201. If both qualifying runs were from the Open class, 40 is added for the handicap, for a final trial #1 total of 241.

Adding the trial #1 and trial #2 totals together, the event total for the dog would be 597. The comparison of that score to the other dogs' scores will determine High in Event.

2nd Example:

A dog runs and Qs in all 3 classes in trial #1. The total of the scores in all 3 classes for trial #1 is 275. Assuming the difference between SCT and run time across all 3 classes in trial #1 is 11, then that total is added to 275, for a new total of 286. If 1 qualifying run was from the Open class, and the other 2 were from excellent, 80 is added for the handicap, for a final trial #1 total of 366.

The same dog runs and Qs in all 3 classes in trial #2. The total of the scores in all classes for trial #2 is 193. Assuming the difference between SCT (MCT for T2B) and run time across all classes in trial #2 is 31, then that total is added to 193, for a new total of 224. If the STD and JWW qualifying runs were from the Novice class, 20 is added for the handicap for those 2 classes, plus 30 for T2B, for a final trial #2 total of 274.

Adding the trial #1 and trial #2 totals together, the event total would be 640. The comparison of that score to the other dogs' scores will determine High in Event.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly by any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
